

2010 Detroit Youth Baseball League- BOYS & BASEBALL PROGRAMS

Important Questions and Things to Know

1. When does the season start and end?

MAY 1 st – JUNE 26 th	10U, 12U & 14U LITTLE LEAGUE / AABC
JUNE 7 th – JULY 31 th	HIGH SCHOOL / AABC
JUNE 12 th – JULY 31 st	T-BALL and COACH-PITCH

2. How do I register and where?

Registration must include a completed & signed registration form, a birth certificate (unless already on file) and full payment. Cash, checks, and money orders (made payable to Think Detroit PAL) are accepted. We can also receive credit card payments at the Willis Office only.

The primary location for registration is at 111 W. Willis, S. of Warren, between Woodward & Cass. **We will have Saturday Registration Drives on Feb. 13th & Mar 13th from 10:00am – 3:00pm at the Willis Office.** Registration can also be sent via mail (111 W. Willis, Detroit, MI 48201) with a check or money order (made payable to Think Detroit PAL).

3. What is the registration fee and what is included?

All participants will receive a full uniform and a full season of games. The league also provides all team equipment except for mitt, cleats, and mouth guard

4. What division will my child play in?

<u>AGES</u>	<u>BIRTHDATES</u>	
Co-ed ages 4-6:	must be born on or after 5/1/03	T-Ball
Co-ed 8 & Under:	must be born on or after 5/1/01	Coach-Pitch
Boys 10 & Under:	must be born on or after 5/1/99	Minors (Pee Wee Reese)
Boys 12 & Under:	must be born on or after 5/1/97	Majors (Willie Mays)
Boys 14 & Under:	must be born on or after 5/1/95	Seniors (Sandy Koufax)
Boys 18 & Under:	must be born on or after 5/1/91	H.S. Division (Connie Mack)

5. Can my child play in a higher age division?

Children can play in a higher age division but they cannot play in a lower division. An 11-year old boy can play 14&U, but a 15-year old boy cannot play 14&U.

6. How are teams assigned?

Players are placed on teams according to the following priorities:

- 1) Player requesting a specific coach and team
- 2) Immediate family members in the same age division
- 3) By zip code and/or area of the city

7. Where and when will games and practices be held?

Most games will be on Saturdays, although there may be occasional games during the week. Practices will be weekday evenings. All games are primarily played at Peterson Park (T-Ball), Jayne Field and Maheras-Gentry in southeast Detroit. *Fields subject to change.

8. How many times per week will my child play?

The coaches determine practice days and times. Parents should expect an average of two to three times per week for games and/or practices.

9. If my child can not participate, can I get my money back?

The registration fee is non-refundable. However, in certain cases, your registration may be allowed to roll over to another sport. You will need to contact the Program Administration Department for more details.
